From the Eurostar

By taxi:

- There is a taxi rank just outside the arrivals hall. During non-peak traffic the journey should take around 20 minutes and cost around 30 euros
- Uber taxis are also available in Brussels

By metro:

- Follow the  sign to the metro station on level -1
- A single journey ticket can be purchased from the kiosk or a machine
- Take metro line 2 or 6 (direction Elisabeth) to Arts-Loi (6th stop)
- Take line 1 (direction Stockel) to Montgomery (4th stop) – Be careful as line 5 also leaves from the same platform but doesn't stop at Montgomery – check the overhead boards
- When you arrive at Montgomery follow the signs for exit 1. This will bring you straight out onto Avenue de Tervuren and our building is a two-minute walk, on the left hand side (look for the multi-coloured windows!)

From the airport

By taxi:

- Licensed taxis are permanently available in front of the arrivals hall. In normal traffic the fare from the airport to the office should be around 35 euros
- The taxi company Autolux offers a 20% discount on return trips from the airport (look out for the Autolux sticker on the rear-view mirror)
